



How to Interview and Gain Wisdom from an Adult



**Apply your heart to instruction
and your ears to words of knowledge.

There are so many people who can help your child to gain wisdom. Interviewing others is a fun way to gain knowledge and wisdom.

Ask the child to choose someone to interview. Help your child come up with a few questions (a few are suggested below) and let her ask the question and then listen for the answer (a valuable skill). You may want her to practice asking you first to gain experience and confidence.

- What was your favorite toy/game?
- What did you like about school? Why?
- What is your favorite food?
- What were your chores as a child?
- What is something important your mom taught you?
- What pets did you have?
- How did you learn about God?
- Tell something important you learned from the Bible.
- What was one thing you learned from a mistake you made?
- What did you enjoy doing with your parents when you were a kid?
- Complete the sentence: I wish I had listened when my dad told me to _____.
- If you could say one thing about money, what would you say?
- What do you like to do for fun?
