# Week of November 6 Esther 4:6-5:2

## **Today's big idea: Prepare to Leave the Comfort Zone**

- Think about the last big trip you went on. How did you prepare for the trip, what did you do, and how far out did you start?
- Risk is required to leave a comfort zone. Which Community Group Guidelines best create a safe space where you can risk being vulnerable with the group?

## **Bible Study**

- Someone pray that God would help us hear from him.
- Use the Bible Storytelling technique to tell the story of Esther.
- Retell the story together as a group.

# In your Bible Storytelling feel free to include some of the beginning of Esther's story if you already know it. If not, just focus on the verses below.

- Read the story from Esther 4:6-5:2 in the Bible.
- What were ways in which Mordecai displayed fear and faith?
- What were ways in which Esther displayed fear and faith?
- What was the fasting and prayer designed to accomplish?

#### As We Go

For this first question you may need to rephrase it by asking, "If you feel challenged do you tend to go back to comfort or take the risk and why?"

 Would you say that your life is controlled more by comfort zones or taking risks for the Lord? Why?

In this second question you might include things like less spiritual maturity, less influence for God's kingdom, or less fruit from his Spirit.

• What are the potential costs of staying in our comfort zones?

### Be prepared to talk about a risk you may need to take and how to prepare for that.

- What can you do to prepare for the risk that you need to take?
- Share prayer requests with one another and also pray for the gospel of Jesus Christ to motivate us out of our comfort zones.
