Acts 20:17-32 /// Week of January 21

Today's big idea: God's mission doesn't belong to Pastor.

Have fun with this one.

- Seeing ourselves as leaders can be difficult sometimes. Adulting can feel the same way. What is something you wish you didn't have to do as an adult?
- Review the Community Group Guidelines together.
- What did you hear in the sermon that caught your attention?
- Someone pray that God would help us hear from him.

Head

This will be difficult to do through Storytelling. If you are up for the challenge then go for it but feel free to simply read the text as a group 2-3 times from different translations.

- Use the Bible Storytelling technique to tell the story of Paul with the Ephesian elders.
- Retell the story together as a group.
- Read the story from Acts 20:17-32 in the Bible.
- How did Paul describe his relationship with the Ephesians?
- What did he encourage the elders to do?
- What did he warn them about?

Heart

The point here is to challenge everyone to think multiplication as a priority but it does include loss. Process the loss and the importance of the focus.

- How did the elders feel about Paul leaving, how did Paul feel, and why were they different?
- What are the benefits of going to start something new whether that might be another Community Group, a ministry or a church?
- How would you feel if your Community Group Leader(s) said they weren't going to be part of your group anymore? Would the group continue? What would you do?

Hands

Help each person set a goal and maybe set goals for your group. Then prepare to follow up on those goals with the individuals and the group.

- How is the Lord challenging you to take steps of faith toward multiplication, disciple making and leadership?
- How can you help others see the importance of multiplying our culture?
- Pray for one another and the multiplication of your group.
