Community Group Leaders Guide

Genesis 37: 26-36 /// Week of March 24

Today's big idea: Is it right?

- What is ONE good thing that happened this past week.
- Review the Community Group Guidelines together.
- What did you hear in the sermon that caught your attention?
- Someone pray that God would help us hear from him.

Head

Invite someone else in the group to do the Bible Storytelling. It is ok if not every detail is remembered during the Bible Storytelling. Everything will be covered when the scripture is read.

- Use Bible Storytelling to tell the story of Joseph being sold by his brothers.
- Retell the story together as a group.
- Read the story from Genesis 37: 26-36 in the Bible.
- Who tore their clothes and why?
- Where did the Midianites sell Joseph? And to who?
- What stands out to you in this passage?

Heart

You may need to model for your group what transparency and vulnerability look like here. Take note of who is really sharing and who is staying on the surface then follow up outside of group.

- Joseph's brothers were jealous. How has jealousy showed up in your life?
- Jacob refused to be comforted (vs. 35) have you or someone close to you "refused" to be comforted? What was the outcome?
- What did you like from this passage? What did you dislike?

Hands

Listen to the group's response. Pair up group members to reach out to one another this week. This can be done, outside of group time.

- What is one way you can apply this truth to your life this week?
- Are you challenged to think differently because of this passage and discussion?
- How can you use this to disciple others?
- How does this impact you? Your relationship with others?
- Pray for one another and ask God's Holy Spirit to help us to do what is right.
